## **2025 ASLE GRADUATE STUDENT PAPER AWARDS**

The Association for the Study of Literature and Environment (ASLE) will once again honor the best work of graduate students by presenting awards for presentations made at its 2025 biennial conference, to be held July 8-11, 2025, at the University of Maryland, College Park.

- One awardee, and up to two honorable mention recipients, will be chosen from the submissions of eligible work.
- Both scholarly papers in ecocriticism and environmental creative writing (any genre) by a graduate student to be presented at the conference are eligible for the awards.
- Those submitting papers must be presenting at the conference, be members of ASLE or an international affiliate, and should have been enrolled as a graduate student at some time within the previous seven months. Those presenting virtually during the July 17-18, 2025, virtual sessions are also eligible.
- Award includes a prize of \$100 and publication in ISLE: Interdisciplinary Studies in
  Literature and Environment; all honorable mention recipients will receive a prize of
  \$100.
- The content that is submitted for the awards must be essentially the same content that is presented at the conference. Submissions longer than 10 double-spaced pages (excluding works cited and endnotes) will not be accepted.

Papers must be submitted as an email attachment in a standard format (doc, docx, or pdf) no later than **May 24, 2025**.
